



ECLIPSE 2017

Checklist

The Total Solar Eclipse will be on August 21st, 2017. For eastern Idaho, the full Eclipse experience will begin around 10:15 a.m. MDT and end around 12:58 p.m. MDT. The Eclipse will reach its totality around 11:33 a.m. MDT and will last approximately 2 minutes and 18 seconds.

- Complete all shopping the week before.
- Have one gallon of drinking water per person in your family for 3-4 days.
- Fill all your vehicles with gas.
- Pick up your prescriptions and medications the week before.
- Wear your eclipse glasses.
- Make your travel plans ahead of time. Be prepared for traffic.
- Know the signs and treatment of heat related illnesses.
- Know the fire risks and restrictions for where you are going to be.
- Take drinking water & a first aid kit if hiking into a viewing area.
