## Learn About Best Practices for these Critical Issues:

- Distance to school can be addressed by smarter land use planning that creates **convenient communities** and by planning **school locations** in the neighborhoods of the students they serve. Those two topics will be addressed in the Safe Routes workshops
- Only half of children who live within a mile of school currently walk or bicycle. This is especially true when neighborhood streets lack essential safety features, such as adequate sidewalks, bike lanes, and crossings and where streets have been designed to serve only high speed cars.
