## HORSESHOE COURTS

For those people who are interested in playing horseshoes, some excellent courts are available in the following parks:

## JOGGING TRAIL

### Sister City Park on Pocatello Creek RD

This 1K fitness trail, developed with a grant from Wells Fargo Corp., provides a complete exercise system. Exercise stations with signed instruction are set periodically along the graded and graveled fitness trail. Stations are graded for various ability levels and interests. Trails starts east of the entrance to Sister City Park and is also accessible from the parks upper level.

## TENNIS COURTS

The City provides the following courts for public use:

- Raymond Park – Grant & Carson (lighted)
- Pocatello High School – N. Hayes & Fremont (lighted)
- Highland High School – 1300 Bench Rd.

## DISC GOLF COURSES

Upper Ross Park has a 9 hole course and Sister City Park has a new 18 hole course for disc golf. Holes are marked with sign posts at each tee. Both courses are free and upkeep is made through donations and volunteer help from local golfers. Sister City is still under construction and donations and labor are still appreciated.
