Participants in field events report to the event site any time during their assigned 35 minutes (see assignments above) to complete three attempts.

Runners report to their event starting line two events prior to their own event, i.e. a runner in event 6 [Boys 50m (7-8)] should report to the starting line as soon as event 4 begins.

If the number of competitors registered for an age group event is small, that event may be run combined with another age/gender group. Places and awards will still be separated by age/gender group. Ribbons for the top three finishers of each 31-event may be picked up 10-15 minutes after the completion of their events.

Qualifying for State: The Hershey's State Meet is Saturday, July 10, at Madison High School. Athlete check-in is 8:00-8:45 a.m., with events beginning at 9:15 a.m. The top three finishers today's meet qualify to participate in the State meet. State meet qualifiers must have shown proof of birth date to local meet organizers before they can be entered in the State meet. Pocatello Hershey's Track & Field Day Meet Rules Overview – Saturday, May 15, 2010

Participants may enter only one local Hershey's meet prior to the State Meet July 10.

Participants are allowed to wear any legal track uniform or T-shirt, shorts (long pants, sweats are okay), and shoes. Relay teams need not be in matching clothing. Participants may not wear shoes designated for spikes. In field events, any shoes designed for turf sports are not allowed. Participants may not compete in their bare feet, slippers or socks.

Participants may enter a maximum of three events, but no more than two running events, including a relay.

Exception: 9-10 year olds and 11-12 years old entered in the relay may participate in an additional event.

In field events, participants take three successive attempts. The longest of the three attempts is recorded as their best mark.

Participants entering a relay may wait until reporting at the starting line to enter the names of all four members of their team.

Starting blocks are not permitted. Each running competitor is allowed one false start.

In the relay, the acceleration zone will not be used and aids (tape or other markings) may not be used.

Attendants (parents, coaches, etc.) may not accompany a competitor to the starting area. Parents and other family members should remain in the stands or outside the fence surrounding the track after the meet begins.

A participant will be disqualified for unsportsmanlike conduct.

Alcohol and tobacco products are prohibited on the Idaho State University campus.

State Meet Rules Overview

Participants may enter only one local Hershey's meet prior to the State Meet July 10.

Participants should wear a modest t-shirt, shorts (long pants, sweats are okay), and shoes. Relay teams need not be in matching clothing. Participants may not wear shoes designated for spikes.
