9. ROSS PARK AQUATICS COMPLEX – POOL AND BUILDING HEATERS PROPOSAL

Parks and Recreation Department staff will be in attendance to provide an overview of the current status of large area pool heaters and main building water heaters at the Ross Park Aquatics Complex.
