Re: Bid Acceptance and Execution of the Agreement for the Sleepy Hollow Lift Station Improvements Project.

Background

The purpose of this project is to fix and relocate the degrading sewer lift station discharge line and eliminate an aerial sewer crossing over the Portneuf river. The project is located along W. Sublette St. from N. Lincoln Ave. to N. Grant Ave. The project includes the installation of new 6" sewer pressure line, connecting to existing sewer manhole, surface repairs, and removal of the aerial sewer crossing. The work will start at the end of August and be completed by the middle of October. Funding is available in the WPC capital account.

Bids were opened for the project on August 6th 2019, with the following results:

A-Plus Contractors, Soda Springs, ID	\$181,772.50
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A-Plus Contractors was the lowest responsive bid at \$181,772.50, and was 45% higher than the Engineers Estimate (\$125,000).

Recommendation

Staff recommends that City Council accept the lowest responsive bid, award the project and authorize execution of the Contract Agreement between A-Plus Contractors and the City of Pocatello for the Sleepy Hollow Lift Station Improvement Project in the amount of \$181,772.50, subject to Legal Department approval.
