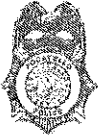
MEMORANDUM

I would also recommend that the Council authorizes the Mayor to sign any all documents necessary to effectuate the completion of the donation to the City of Pocatello.

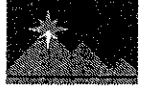

The Pocatello Police Department has a specialized unit named Crisis Negotiation Team. The CNT function is to speak with suspects in hopes to reach a peaceful way to end a high profile or violent incidents. This CNT unit is part of the Immediate Response Team which is called out along with the PPD SWAT team.

CNT has an equipment need for a vehicle or mobile negotiation platform to hold, charge, and store all the equipment needed. We have been looking for a functional vehicle for a couple years.

The Bannock County Commissioners decided to donate a functional ambulance to the PPD CNT to fill the equipment need. The vehicle has been donated at no cost to the department; including function emergency equipment on the vehicle. The City fleet manager Russ Simmons has personally looked over the vehicle and assured that the City Fleet department has all the tools needed to keep up with the maintenance of the vehicle.

We are requesting the City Council review and approve the donated vehicle for CNT.

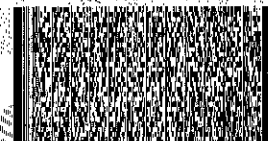
