SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
WALKABILITY DISCUSSION
APRIL 4, 2019

Council members Heidi Adamson, Rick Cheatum, Jim Johnston and Linda Leeuwrik were present for a Walkability Discussion meeting held by Engineering Department staff. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss walkability areas in Pocatello. The meeting began at 9:00 a.m. in City Hall Council Chambers at 911 North 7th Avenue.

An overview of research regarding walkability for pedestrians and bicyclists in various communities was given. The economic impacts of having safe and planned routes for individuals was reviewed.
