• STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT:

PATCHING

Street Operations will continue patching potholes and curb lines in preparation for upcoming pavement treatments, which may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed.

MILLING AND PAVING

Street Operations Department will be milling and paving Spaulding Lane and Park Lane this week. Crews will mill and pave Spaulding Lane on Monday, September 23 and Tuesday, September 24, 2019. Once finished, Street Crews will begin milling and paving Park Lane on Wednesday, September 25 and Thursday, September 26, 2019. The roads will be closed as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the area.

PAVEMENT MARKINGS

Street Operations Department will continue painting crosswalks and other pavement markings in various parts of the city. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to use caution to avoid wet paint and may experience delays at the work sites.

JETTING STORM DRAIN LINES

Street Operations will be jetting storm drain lines throughout the city. There may be intermittent lane closures while work is being performed.

• IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT:

• I-15 ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Reconstruction of Rose Road Interchange on I-15. This project will improve mobility and safety on Interstate 15. Construction will be completed in late 2019.

• Northgate Overpass above I-15 is currently under construction and projected to be completed in the fall of 2019.

• CONTRACTORS:

NORTHGATE

IMC (private contractor) continues to have Chubbuck Road closed for construction. Closure will be at Fairgrounds Road and Olympus Drive. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes, follow posted detours and obey posted 25mph speed limit signs. IMC expects to reopen Chubbuck Road the first week of October 2019.

• WATER POLLUTION CONTROL:

• SEWER LINE INSTALLATION

Crews will begin installing a new sewer line along West Sublette Street, from North Lincoln Avenue to North Grant Avenue. Crews will work between the hours of 7 a.m. to approximately 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties. The work will cause short-term disruptions to sewer service and crews will notify residents before interruptions are scheduled to take place. Officials ask parents and guardians to warn children about the safety hazard and to have them stay a safe distance from the construction area. The project is anticipated to take four weeks to complete but due to unforeseen circumstances, the work schedule may change. PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

• BENTON STREET BRIDGE

Southbound shoulder on 1st Ave., under the Benton Street Bridge, will be closed periodically for the next few months, as needed, to allow the Contractor to perform work. Benton Street Bridge will be reduced to one lane of traffic each direction over the bridge.

• WATER DEPARTMENT:

• PROJECT ON NORTH LINCOLN AVENUE

Beginning Monday, September 16, 2019, crews from the City of Pocatello Water Department will begin installing a new water line on North Lincoln Avenue. The project is anticipated to take approximately eight weeks to complete.

Crews will work between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to approximately 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day.
