

Notice of 5311 and 5310 Grant Application and Proposed Program of Projects

The City of Pocatello Public Transit Department announces its 2020 Idaho Transportation Department Grant Application (grant number to be assigned at a later date) under Section 5311 and 5310 for the rural area, and provides a Proposed Program of Projects (POP) and Proposed Budget. The Grant Application and POP consist of Operations, Administration, Preventive Maintenance, Capital, and Mobility Management. (See details under the POP below).

A Public Hearing will be held at the regular city council meeting of November 7, 2019 at 6:00 pm. The location is City of Pocatello City Hall, Council Chambers, 911 North 7<sup>th</sup>, Pocatello, Idaho. The public will have an opportunity to comment and such comment will be considered in the final formulation of the Proposed Program of Projects. Subsequent to public input the POP/Budget will become final.
