➤ **STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT**

- **PATCHING**

Street Operations will continue patching potholes and curb lines in preparation for upcoming pavement treatments, which may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed.

- **PAVEMENT MARKINGS**

Street Operations Department will be painting crosswalks and other pavement markings in various parts of the city. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to use caution to avoid wet paint and expect delays at work sites.

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT

The City of Pocatello Water Department will continue replacing the water mainline on Lincoln Ave from West Clark Street heading southeast toward Bonneville Street. Crews will work between the hours of 7:00 AM to approximately 5:00 PM, Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while work is being performed. However, every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties

➤ **WATER POLLUTION CONTROL**

JETTING SEWER LINES

Crews will be jetting sewer lines throughout the city. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work.

➔ **IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

NIGHT CONSTRUCTION ON YELLOWSTONE AVENUE BETWEEN THE INTERSECTION OF CEDAR STREET AND FLANDRO DRIVE BEGINS JUNE 16TH.

- Starting June 16, 2020, between 7:00 PM and 7:00 AM night work will take place while crews begin re-paving the roadway. The milling and paving will first begin on the outer lanes running south and then north along the curb line. Work will then include milling from the inside lane to the centerline of the road. Work is expected to be completed by the beginning of July. There will be intermittent evening road closures at Industrial Lane, West Griffith Road, West Chapel Road, East Chapel Road, Pearl Street, and East Griffith Road. Temporary traffic control will be set-up and nightly traffic detours will be in effect during the time of construction.
