- **PATCHING, GRINDING THERMOPLASTICS and TREE TRIMMING**

Street Operations will continue patching potholes, curb lines and grinding off thermoplastics where necessary, in preparation for upcoming pavement treatments. Crews will also be trimming overgrown trees on roads receiving a treatment this season. These services may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed.

- **PAVEMENT MARKINGS**

Street Operations Department will continue painting crosswalks and other pavement markings in various parts of the city. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to use caution to avoid wet paint and expect delays at work sites.

- **SIGNAL WORK**

Traffic crews will be replacing the signal cabinet at the intersection of McKinley Avenue and West Alameda Road. Work is anticipated to start on Tuesday, July 14 and be finished by end of day. The signal will not be functioning during this time. Temporary stop signs will be placed for traffic management. Drivers are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT

The City of Pocatello Water Department will continue replacing the water mainline on Lincoln Ave from West Clark Street heading southeast toward Bonneville Street. Crews will work between the hours of 7:00 AM to approximately 5:00 PM, Monday through Thursday. During

the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while work is being performed. However, every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties
