➔ STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT

- **SWEEPING**
 - Monday: Northend
 - Tuesday: East Side
 - Wednesday: Fairway
 - Thursday: West Side

- **JETTING STORM DRAIN LINES**

Street Operations will be jetting storm drain lines throughout the city. There may be intermittent lane closures while work is being performed.

- **PATCHING**

Street Operations will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the city in preparation for upcoming pavement treatments, which may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed.

- **TREE TRIMMING**

Operations crews will be trimming trees throughout the city in preparation for the upcoming pavement treatments. This may require intermittent lane and/or road closures as work is performed. Motorist are advised to expect delays in the area.

- **SIGNAL WORK**
 - **Pole Line Rd/W Cedar St**

Signal maintenance will be performed on the SE corner of Pole Line Road and West Cedar Street on Wednesday, June 16th, beginning at 6:30 am. The signal will be inoperable during the maintenance. Crews will have temporary stop signs in place for the duration of the signal work. There may be intermittent lane closures while work is being performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

WATER LINE INSTALL

Starting Tuesday, June 1st, crews from the City of Pocatello Water Department will begin replacing the water main line on Jefferson Avenue. The project will start at the intersection of Jefferson Avenue and East Poplar Street and continue north to Alameda Road. During the project, detours and road closures will occur. Motorists are asked to use alternate routes when possible. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 a.m. to approximately 6:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday. Access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. However, every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties. The work may cause short-term disruptions to water service. Individuals in and around the construction zone are encouraged to keep a supply of drinking water available. Officials ask parents and guardians to warn children about the safety hazard and to have them stay a safe distance from the construction area. The project is anticipated to take six weeks to complete but due to unforeseen circumstances, the work schedule may change.
