Oral and written comments may be offered at the above-stated time and place. Other written comments must be received on or before 12:00 noon, Thursday, August 5, 2021, at: City of Pocatello, Planning and Development Services Department, ATTN: Christine Howe, PO Box 4169, 911 North 7th, Pocatello, ID 83205-4169.

Responses to any written comments that are not accepted into the Action Plans under consideration must be provided within 5 working days by the Planning and Development Services Department. If the written response from Planning and Development Services staff is unsatisfactory and depending upon the nature of the comment, the concern may be addressed to the Mayor or the City Council. At their August 5, 2021 meeting, the Pocatello City Council will then take action on these matters: Increasing the PY2021 Housing Budget. A summary of public input (and any and all staff responses to unaccepted or unincorporated comments) will then become attachments to the final documents submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Beginning Tuesday, June 22, 2021, at 12 noon MST, the documents under consideration will become available for all citizens at the Marshall Public Library (113 South Garfield), Pocatello City Hall (911 North 7th), L.I.F.E., Inc. (640 Pershing Avenue), NeighborWorks Pocatello (206 North Arthur), the Housing Authority of the City of Pocatello (711 North 6th), and on the City of Pocatello's website at www.pocatello.us.
