



## **ROAD CLOSURES & TRAFFIC REPORTS**

### **➔ STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT**

- **SWEEPING**

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

- **PATCHING**

Street Operations will be patching potholes and curb lines throughout the city in preparation for upcoming pavement treatments, which may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed.

- **PAVING**

**Tuesday, June 29 - Hiline Rd.**

Street Operations crews will be paving Hiline Rd. from E Quinn Rd. to Andesite Dr. This portion of the road will be closed as work is being performed. Detours will be posted. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

**Wednesday, June 30 – Dolostone Dr.**

Street Operations crews will be paving a portion of the road, just north of 1065 Dolostone Dr. This will require a partial road closure as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

### **➔ WATER DEPARTMENT**

#### **WATER LINE INSTALL**

Starting Tuesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, crews from the City of Pocatello Water Department will begin replacing the water main line on Jefferson Avenue. The project will start at the intersection of Jefferson Avenue and East Poplar Street and continue north to Alameda Road. During the project, detours and road closures will occur. Motorists are asked to use alternate routes when possible. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 a.m. to approximately 6:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday. Access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. However, every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction

zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties. The work may cause short-term disruptions to water service. Individuals in and around the construction zone are encouraged to keep a supply of drinking water available. Officials ask parents and guardians to warn children about the safety hazard and to have them stay a safe distance from the construction area. The project is anticipated to take six weeks to complete but due to unforeseen circumstances, the work schedule may change. **JETTING SEWER LINES**

**June 29 – July 1**

Crews with Cannon Builders will be closing the Monte Vista Bridge over Interstate 15 for further repairs. Detours will be posted.

**Friday, July 2**

VSS will be performing roadway surface treatments to the west leg of the E Gould St. and US 30 (Garrett Way) intersection. This will require intermittent lane closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.
