• **CRACK SEALING**

Street Operations will continue crack sealing throughout the city this week. Treatment will require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays.

Street crews will be raising storm water manholes throughout the city this week. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays.

WATER LINE INSTALL

Crews with the City of Pocatello Water Department will continue working on North Grant Avenue. The total project area will span over 4,500 feet on North Grant Avenue from Center Street to West Day Street. During the project, road closures and detours will occur. Motorists are asked to use alternate routes when possible. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 a.m. to approximately 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. However, every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties.
