Ride the PRT Bus to Ross Park and the Library this Summer! Starts Mon., June 6th

It's easy, fun, and FREE for youths 18yrs and younger!! Use the Summer Youth Pass to catch a Pocatello Regional Transit (PRT) bus at any marked bus stop, and just tell the driver you'd like to go to Ross Park or the Library. There may be a transfer, but the driver will direct you to the correct bus connection. The D Route bus takes you directly to, and picks you up next to the Aquatic Complex and Library entrances. Summer Youth Passes can be obtained at the PRT Office, Community Recreation Center, Aquatic Complex, Zoo Idaho and both the Marshall and Portneuf District Libraries.
