VOLUNTEER SERVICE PROGRAM

The Pocatello ~ Partners in Pride Volunteer Service Program is a fun and worthwhile partnership between the City of Pocatello and the citizens of Pocatello to promote pride and maintain the livability of the city. Through this program, citizens play an integral part in making our community cleaner and safer. This is a great way to promote community pride and goodwill within your organization or neighborhood and among family and friends.

Pocatello ~ Partners in Pride Volunteer Service Program

Who can participate?

- Individuals 16 years of age or older
- Organizations
- Businesses
- Schools

You participate by:

- Committing to a two-year period and a minimum of three cleanups per year;
- Removing litter and weeds along a designated street section;
- Removing litter and weeds along a designated section of the Portneuf River Greenway;
- Removing litter and weeds from City-owned property;
- Removing litter and weeds from stormwater retention areas;
- Removing debris from the top of stormwater grates; or
- Cleaning other approved landscaping and beautification areas.

How to get started:

- Contact the Program Coordinator for an application package at: (208) 234-6192;
- Return the application to the Program Coordinator for processing; and
- The Program Coordinator will send a confirmation letter to you.

The City's commitment:

- We provide safety training;
- We provide roadside traffic control signs and cones;
- We loan safety vests;
- We provide free trash bags and dispose of the trash you collect;
- We require you or your representative to execute a responsibility waiver. All participants must be at least 16 years of age; and
- We install purchased recognition sign(s).

Signage

The City provides volunteer groups with the option of purchasing Pocatello ~ Partners in Pride Volunteer Service Program signs to help recognize their efforts in keeping Pocatello beautiful.

- Signs are not required. It is up to each volunteer group to decide whether or not to purchase signs for their cleanup area. The signs cost approximately \$15.00.
- If purchased, signs must be obtained through the Pocatello ~ Partners in Pride Volunteer Service Program.
- The City will erect and maintain all signs.

The Sanitation Department also coordinates and manages the City's "Partners in Pride" container program, which permits residential customers the free use of either a 3-yd dumpster or a 17-yd roll-off box to remove unwanted items or work on other projects that may require greater than usual trash service. This free service is available on a first-come, first-served basis. The containers may be reserved for a 48-hour period or over a weekend by calling the Sanitation Department at 234-6192.
