

NOTICE INVITING BIDS

RECEIPT OF BIDS: Sealed Bids will be received at the office of the City of Pocatello, OWNER of the WORK, located at 911 North 7th Street, Pocatello, Idaho 83205, until 2 pm, on September 17, 2020, for construction of the "Five Million Gallon Tank Interior Repainting" project. All bids are to be delivered to the **Attention of Ruth Newsom, City Clerk**. Any Bids received after the specified time will not be considered.

OBTAINING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: The Contract Documents are entitled "Five Million Gallon Tank Interior Repainting". Contract Documents may be obtained at the office of the ENGINEER beginning August 24, 2020. Documents will be provided in PDF format at no charge. Printed documents will be provided at a cost of \$45 per copy. The scale of the reduced drawings is about one-half of original scale. Plans are also available for review at FW Dodge McGraw Hill Information Services, 1743 West Alexander, West Valley City, Utah.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Work includes abrasive blasting and recoating of the interior of a five million gallon welded steel, ground elevation, potable water storage tank with interior and exterior tank modifications. Tank modifications will include installation of a new OWNER furnished air vent, removal of existing painter rail, removal of temporary roof plate angle supports, and connection bolt replacement on interior of tank.

SITE OF WORK: The site of the work is located at near the end of Fore Road, Pocatello, Idaho, at the following coordinates N42.8459, W112.4497.

PRE-BID SITE VISIT: A formal pre-bid site visit will be conducted for this work on September 2, 2020, at 10:00 am. Bidders are requested to meet at City's Water Department office located at 1889 North Arthur Street, Pocatello, Idaho, with a site visit and interior tank inspection. Bidders are to provide rubber boots suitable for tank entry in about 8 to 12-inches of water. Bidders unable to attend the prebid meeting may visit the site by contacting Harold Hargraves, City of Pocatello, at (208) 705-4833 for site access, but tank will not be out of service for internal inspection.

COMPLETION OF WORK: All WORK shall be completed within sixteen (16) calendar weeks from notice to proceed. Notice to proceed is anticipated to be issued on November 2, 2020. Time is of the essence.

OPENING OF BIDS: The Bids will be publicly opened and read at 2 pm on September 17, 2020, at the above-mentioned office of the OWNER.

BID SECURITY: Each Bid shall be accompanied by cash, certified or cashier's check, or bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid price payable to the City of Pocatello as a guarantee that the Bidder, if his Bid is accepted, will promptly execute the contract, provide evidence of insurance, and furnish a satisfactory faithful performance

bond in the amount of 100 percent of the total bid price and a payment bond in the amount of 100 percent of the total bid price.

ADDRESS AND MARKING OF BID: The envelope enclosing the Bid shall be sealed and addressed to the City of Pocatello and delivered or mailed to Attention: Ruth Newsom, City Clerk, 911 North 7th Street (street zip 83201), P.O. Box 4169, Pocatello, Idaho 83205-4169. The envelope shall be plainly marked in the upper left-hand corner with the name and address of the Bidder and shall bear the words "Bid for," followed by the title of the Contract Documents for the WORK and the date and hour of opening of Bids. The certified or cashier's check, or Bidder's bond shall be enclosed in the same envelope with the Bid.

PROJECT ADMINISTRATION: All requests for bid documents and questions relative to this project prior to the opening of Bids shall be directed to the ENGINEER for the project.


