Resources & Reporting in Idaho

Idaho Code 16-1605 – Reporting of Abuse, Abandonment or Neglect

Everyone in Idaho is considered a mandatory reporter. If you have witnessed, heard of, or suspect that a child is experiencing abuse or neglect, it is YOUR responsibility to make a good faith report. You do not have to have evidence to make a report. Reports can be anonymous.
